Position Summary: Provide culturally competent individual/group therapy, case management, assessments and intakes to chronically mentally ill within the Hispanic community. Mostly adults and adolescents. Experience with drug abuse is helpful.

Essential Job Functions

1. Provide psychological assessments/problem identification, crisis interventions, and individual, group, and/or family therapy to assigned Consumers.
2. Provide case management services to Consumers as needed.
3. Develop treatment plans; monitor treatment progress and follow-up at disposition times.
4. Assist Consumers with psychological development, social development, and rehabilitation.
5. Coordinate Consumer's use of other MHCD programs and outside community resources.
6. Coordinate medication/medicinal needs of Consumers with medical sources.
7. Maintain accurate and timely clinical records consistent with MHCD's standards.
8. Coordinate Consumer billing and modify treatment program in accordance with insurance coverage, plan provisions, and individual ability to pay.
9. Participate in team meetings, in-services, and supervisory sessions as required.

Job Requirements

Education: (MHT II) Masters Degree/Doctorate in psychology, social work, or other related human services degree. Licensed, Bilingual English/Spanish required

Experience: Three to five years providing clinical mental health services to youth/families. Community-based experience helpful.

Skills: Knowledge of methods of psychotherapy. Knowledge of community resources. Ability to assess crisis situations and intervene appropriately. Familiarity with the DSM IV and diagnostic techniques. Effective written and verbal communication skills. Ability to work flexible and on-call hours which may be required.
